

# Pre-Professional Training Program Uniform Policy

#### **Uniform Options**

At Arizona Repertory Ballet, we believe that dancers should have the opportunity to develop a love for ballet in a comfortable and encouraging space with trained and compassionate instructors. We believe in a balance between the traditional structure of ballet and the idea that children perform their best when they feel their best. As such, we are offering the following options for our dancers uniforms for the 2025-2026 season.

#### Ladies:

All leotards can be purchased through Discount Dance Supply:

Theatricals cotton pinched V-back Leotard (tank, short sleeve, long sleeve options for your dancer)

Adult Style Numbers: TH5559, TH5556, TH5560 Girls Style Numbers: TH5559C, TH5556C, TH5560C

Please purchase your dancer's uniform in the following color:

Level 1 "Light Pink"
Level 2 "Coral"
Level 3 & 4 "Mauve"
Level 5 & 6 "Burgandy"
Level 7 "Navy"
Level 8 "Black"

Additionally, our 5-7 dancers can choose the *Bloch Women's Essential Camisole Leotard Style Number L5607* 

All ladies are required to have pink tights, pink ballet shoes, and hair neatly secured in a classical ballet bun. Only small earrings are permitted.

We encourage all our dancers to be professionally fit for their ballet shoes. Dee's Dancewear, Natalie and Co., and Barry's Capezio are all options for ballet shoes.

Arizona Repertory Ballet does not sell uniform leotards, tights, or shoes.

### Boys/Mens:

Theatricals, Boys Fitted Short Sleeve Dance T-Shirt, White Style No: TH5133C

Maria, Boys Short Sleeve Leotard, White Style No: ME638C

Maria, Boys "Gregor" High Waisted Dance Leggings, Gray Style No: ME802C

Boys must also wear a dance belt if age 10 or over.

White shoes and White socks Bloch Boy's Mens Socks: Style: B0001

## PBT, Jazz, Modern, Contemporary

All dancers for all other classes: Dancers may wear black leggings or black jazz pants with a plain black shirt or their uniform leotard. Black Jazz shoes (highly recommended) or black socks are required.

#### Misc Dress Code

Students are to wear their hair and bangs neatly away from their face and secured in a classical ballet bun. Ponytails are only allowed in Contemporary/Jazz class. If you need assistance in learning how to make the proper bun, please notify school staff. Leotards and tights are to be clean with no holes, etc. Students that come to class in dirty leotards, tights or unkempt hair will have their parents notified.

Male students must secure their hair appropriately and comparable to the standards upheld for ladies and commensurate with male dancers internationally.

Students are not to wear jewelry (other than stud earrings).

Students are required to wear some form of cover up over the dance clothes when entering and leaving Arizona Repertory Ballet. Students are also not to wear their ballet slippers outside of Arizona Repertory Ballet on asphalt, grass, or dirt, as this ruins their shoes and can get dirty or scratch the studio floors.
